Comments - Survey of parents of current preschool students:

Comments on surveys that returned <u>half day</u>:

For lower county kids that makes a 4-6 year old have an additional 1-2 hours to their school day based on travel. That is ~ a 9 hour work day. A young child shouldn't have to struggle based on where they live. The school should accommodate all children equally. In my opinion all schools should be centralized in Bicknell. Pre K-6 in the middle school & 7-12 in the high school. Thank you for allowing me to express my concerns & opinions on the matter. I trust that the Wayne School District will make the best decision for all involved.

- 1. I am in support of early childhood education but feel it is best done in the home w/ the child's parents.
- I am concerned w/the length of time my child would be away from home as she is on the bus nearly an hour. Especially if we go to 4 longer school days, that would put her away from home for 9+ hours...longer than most adults work.
- 3. Studies have shown that while all day kindergarten is beneficial that first year of school, by the end of 1st grade that impact depreciates considerably. See www.ernweb.com
- 4. I strongly believe it is not what is done in the school that will help the child succeed but what is done in the home. I would hope that we could have the option because what works for one family doesn't always work for another.

Kids spend too much of their lives in school. Let them be kids while they still can and still want to be.

I believe that a half day would be good for the standard child but for the children who are having a hard time maybe offer a more one on one or a full day to help keep them on par.

Due to the attention span of many kindergarteners I suggest holding half-day kindergarten to create a positive learning experience for young kids. Eight hours in a classroom for a 5-6 year old child can be very overwhelming. In my opinion, half-day kindergarten would be a better transition to being a full-time student in the 1st grade.
