Student fees are limited to \$300.			
<p>A waiver shall be granted to a student if charging the fee would deny the student the opportunity to participate in a class or school-sponsored or supported activity because of an inability to pay a fee.</p>			
A student is eligible for waiver upon providing verification that:			
<p>The student qualifies based on income eligibility levels established annually by the State Superintendent;</p>			
The student receives SSI;			
The family receives TANF funding;			
The student is in foster care through the Utah Division of Child and Family Services; or			
The student is in state custody.			
<p>A student who does not qualify based on the foregoing may also be granted a waiver if the student is not reasonably capable of paying the fee based on extenuating circumstances. Such circumstances might include exceptional financial burden, loss or substantial reduction of income, or extraordinary medical expenses.</p>			
<p>In the event that circumstances change for a student or family such that fee waiver eligibility no longer exists, the school may charge a proportional share of a fee or a reduced fee reflecting the change in eligibility.</p>			
Appeals may be made if a student is denied a waiver.
